Lent begins with Ash Wednesday when there will be a Choral Eucharist with Imposition of Ashes at 7.30pm in addition to Choral Evensong at 5.15pm.

On Sunday 26th February, the first Sunday of Lent, there will be a simple bread and soup lunch after the 11am Eucharist. The lunch is free and everyone is very welcome. We will be inviting donations towards the work of the Little Brothers of the Good Shepherd amongst our city's homeless.
